Sister Cecile LeBoeuf R.H.S.J. 1919 - 2013

Sister Cecile LeBoeuf died peacefully in hospital in Kingston on November 20th, 2013. She was 94 years of age. 66 of those years were dedicated to religious life, serving the needs of the sick and the elderly in our Windsor Ontario facilities; Hotel-Dieu Grace Hospital and Villa Maria Home for the Aged.



Sister Cecile entered religious life in 1945 at Hotel-Dieu in Windsor. She received a Bachelor of Science degree in 1955, and eventually trained in Laboratory Technology and taught the students in the Laboratory in Hotel-Dieu Hospital, part of the School of Nursing program that ran there until 1973. She went on to become

the Supervisor of the Lab for 18 years, served as Sister Superior for 12 years at the hospital and for six years at Villa Maria. Sister was active with the hospital auxiliary for many years and an avid fundraiser for both Villa Maria and the HDGH Foundation. Sister LeBoeuf also holds the distinction of being the last Sister to serve as Hospital Administrator before the first lay CEO, Roman Mann, was hired in 1968.

With the closure of the Windsor community in 2007, Sister Cecile moved to Regional House in Kingston until it was closed in 2012, when she was part of the move of the RHSJ Sisters to Heath Field the Motherhouse for the Sisters of Providence. Her many years of service to Catholic healthcare in the Windsor area will be remembered for many years to come.

Hotel Dieu Shaver Health & Rehabilitation Centre St. Catharines, ON **CONGRATULATIONS!**

In a report released by the National Research Corporation Canada (NRCC) and the Ontario Hospital Association (OHA), Hotel Dieu Shaver was named Top Performer for patient ratings in Overall Satisfaction for Inpatient Rehabilitation among 30 hospitals, and was also in the 90th percentile for patient ratings for 'Would You Recommend' for Inpatient Rehabilitation.

Hotel-Dieu Grace Healthcare, Windsor ON

As was previously communicated in the Torch, the Hospitals in Windsor have undergone a significant realignment of services. As a result of this realignment 1,800 former Hotel-Dieu Grace Hospital employees became Windsor Regional employees and 1,000 employees on the Tayfour campus (formerly part of Windsor Regional Hospital) became Hotel-Dieu Grace employees; and 71 administrative employees from the former Hotel-Dieu Grace Hospital transferred to the new site.

In recognition of these significant changes, Sister Lynn Levo, CSJ was engaged to facilitate sessions with staff to (a) provide staff the opportunity to discuss and acknowledge the 'endings' they are experiencing in this transition, and (b) provide tools and techniques for staff to navigate this transition and other transitions in their lives.

Over 180 staff members have participated in these two hour sessions. The response from staff has been overwhelmingly positive. Sister Lynn is now providing similar sessions for our Board and management team.
