




### Measures taken to reduce overcrowding at Stella-Maris-de-Kent Hospital

Vitalité Health Network's measures to reduce overcrowding at Stella-Maris-de-Kent Hospital, a CHI sponsored facility, and the Dr. Georges-L.-Dumont University Hospital Centre (UHC) are continuing until April 23, 2021. Because of overcrowding the Health Authority has issued the following measures: Admissions are strictly limited to cases absolutely requiring hospitalization; Some surgeries may be postponed; All cases currently hospitalized will be reviewed to determine whether certain



patients could safely be returned home or transferred to another care setting. Vitalité Health Network thanks the public for their understanding and regrets any inconvenience that this situation could cause.
